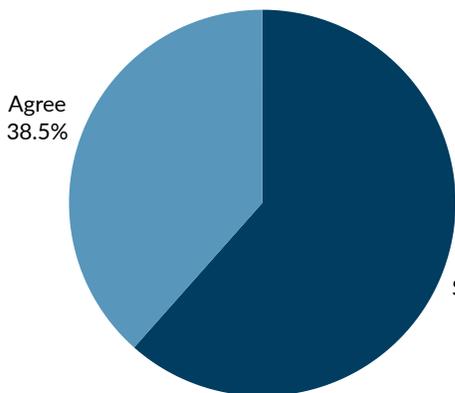

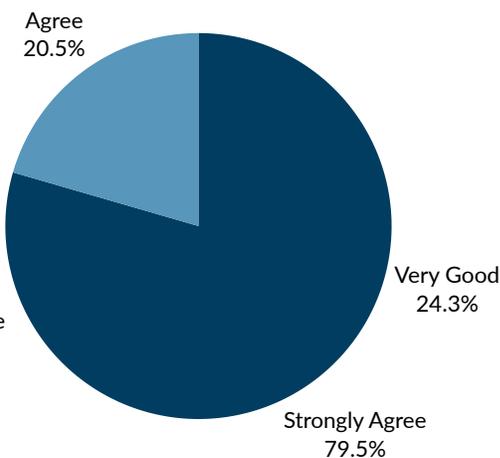
2025 Outcome Measures

(39 survey respondents of 235+ attendees)

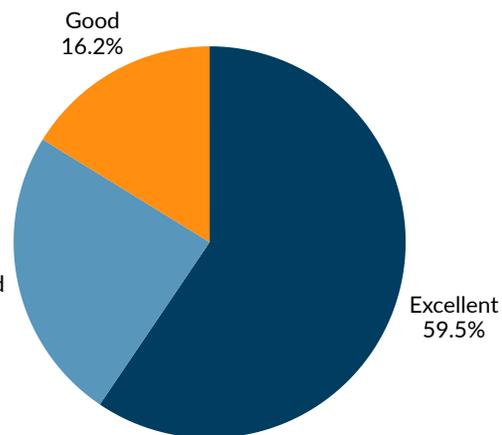
Program Relevance to Attendees' Work



Content Matched Objectives

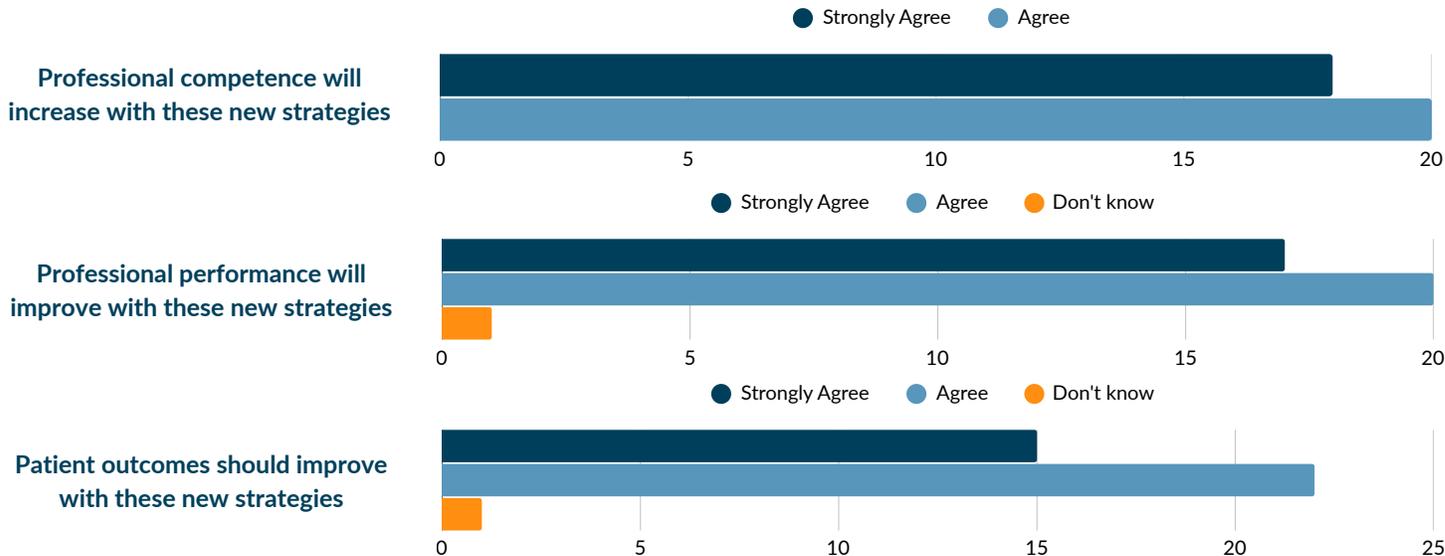


Balanced View of Therapeutic Options

Qualitative Participant Feedback

"I have a better understanding of the need to address patient care problems at the systems level. The program underscored the importance of upstream determinants of health, including environmental factors. It is important for clinicians to remember that we work within a larger context that has a profound impact on patient outcomes."
